Directions

From Providence and east

Follow I-95 South into Connecticut. Take Exit 48 to merge onto I-91 North (toward Hartford). Take Exit 12 (Washington Ave.) and turn right onto Route 5/Washington Ave., and follow for 1.5 miles. Turn right on Bradley Street. Continue straight through the Bassett Road intersection. The entrance to campus is directly ahead.

From New York City and west

Follow I-95 North to New Haven. Merge onto I-91 North (toward Hartford) and follow for 8.6 miles. Take Exit 12 (Washington Ave.) and turn right onto Route 5/Washington Ave., and follow for 1.5 miles. Turn right on Bradley Street. Continue straight through the Bassett Road intersection. The entrance to campus is directly ahead.

From Hartford and east

Take I-91 South to Exit 12 (Washington Ave.). Turn right onto Route 5/Washington Ave., and follow for 1.5 miles. Turn right on Bradley Street. Continue straight through the Bassett Road intersection. The entrance to campus is directly ahead.

From Boston

Take the Mass Pike/I-90 West to Exit 9, merging onto I-84 West toward US-20/Hartford/New York City. Follow for 41.7 miles. Follow signs for Charter Oak Bridge/CT-15/I-91/New York City. Take Exit 87 for I-91/Brainard Road toward Brainard/Airport Road. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for I-91 and merge onto I-91 South and follow for 27.3 miles. Take Exit 12 (Washington Ave.), then turn right onto Route 5/Washington Ave., and follow for 1.5 miles. Turn right on Bradley Street. Continue straight through the Bassett Road intersection. The entrance to campus is directly ahead.

From Northern New Jersey

Take I-95 North/New Jersey Turnpike North to New Haven. Merge onto I-91 North (toward Hartford) and follow for 8.6 miles. Take Exit 12 (Washington Ave.) and turn right onto Route 5/Washington Ave., and follow for 1.5 miles. Turn right on Bradley Street. Continue straight through the Bassett Road intersection. The entrance to campus is directly ahead.

From western Connecticut and upper New York State

Take I-90 East toward Boston. Take Exit 4 for I-91/US-5 toward Springfield/Holyoke. Merge onto I-91 South via the ramp to Springfield/I-391. Take Exit 12 (Washington Ave.) and turn right onto Route 5/Washington Ave., and follow for 1.5 miles. Turn right on Bradley Street. Continue straight through the Bassett Road intersection. The entrance to campus is directly ahead.
